Federal agencies kick off Combined Federal Campaign

Walla Walla, Wash. – Federal Government agencies of Walla Walla County announce the kick-off of the annual Combined Federal Campaign (CFC), which will run through November 14, 2003.

The CFC is the once-a-year solicitation of all federal employees wishing to contribute to charities of their choice through payroll deductions or one-time cash donations.

This year's goal is to obtain pledges totaling fifty-six thousand and two hundred (\$56,200) from a workforce of about 900 federal employees. Contributors may select from several hundred local, national and international organizations that are included in the CFC brochure.
